Travel Information

- To get to Ann Arbor Michigan, the easiest/closest airport is the Detroit Metro Airport (DTW). In addition to hosting many airlines, DTW is a Delta and Spirit Airlines hub and offers many direct flights.
- The drive from DTW to Ann Arbor is about 30-mins (give or take traffic). There are many rental car options available at the airport such as [Enterprise](#) and [Hertz](#)
- A pickup for an Uber or Lyft is easy at DTW, with an area dedicated to [rideshare pickups](#). The cost of a rideshare varies on the time of day/demand but generally is about \$40-\$60 to get to Ann Arbor
- The [Michigan Flyer](#) has many bus times each day and has a direct route to Ann Arbor. Tickets are \$16 a person. The bus station drop-off is downtown Ann Arbor ([Blake Transit Station](#))
